- **7. Airline Travel Arrangements to Your Site:** Include detailed travel arrangement costs for economy class airline tickets to your World Heritage Site. All departures should be from Miami, Florida, on June 12, 2014. Prices are for round-trip travel. Be sure to include your source(s).
